POLICY RE: ABSENCE FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW DUE TO PREGNANCY OR DISABILITY

(Approved by Council, January 10, 2005)

- Fees will be required when due in the normal manner, whether or not the absence is relatively foreseeable.
- Following an absence of at least 3 months, a member may request the reimbursement of the practicing fees paid to the Law Society.
- A request for reimbursement must be received within 3 months of the end of the period of absence from practice *unless Council deems that an extension of time is appropriate in the circumstances (New).*
- The only circumstances that will be approved for reimbursement are those related to maternity or medical disability (whether physical or mental).
- Members requesting reimbursement under this Policy are required to provide the following:
 - Letter from a qualified medical practitioner attesting to the medical requirement for the absence, and
 - An executed affidavit that the member did not engage in the practice of law during the entire period of the absence.
- Approval for reimbursement under this policy will rest with Council.
- Upon approval, the member will be assumed to have been on non-practising status for the period involved, and will be reimbursed the difference between the fee for practicing and non-practising for that period, prorated monthly.
- This reimbursement policy does not apply to insurance premiums paid.
- "Disability" is defined in accordance with the interpretation in use by the PEI Human Rights Commission.
